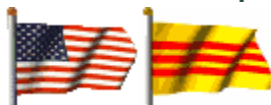

Report on flag saluting protocols:

Vietnam Veterans of America (VVA), National Chair, Government Affairs Committee

VVA Texas State Council, Government Affairs Chair & State Legislative Coordinator

Legislative Liaison, Texas Coalition of Veteran Organizations

Vice President, Legislative Affairs, Military Service Coalition

Legislative Coordinator, Texas Association of Vietnam Veterans

The president signed the Amendment to Section 9 of Title 4 of the U.S. Code| which was attached with the H.R. 4986 Bill under the National Defense Authorization Act of 2008. The amendment reads:

SEC. 594. CONDUCT BY MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES AND VETERANS OUT OF UNIFORM DURING HOISTING, LOWERING, OR PASSING OF UNITED STATES FLAG.

Section 9 of title 4, United States Code, is amended by striking `all persons present' and all that follows through the end of the section and inserting the following: `all persons present in uniform should render the military salute. Members of the Armed Forces and veterans who are present but not in uniform may render the military salute. All other persons present should face the flag and stand at attention with their right hand over the heart, or if applicable, remove their headdress with their right hand and hold it at the left shoulder, the hand being over the

heart. Citizens of other countries present should stand at attention. All such conduct toward the flag in a moving column should be rendered at the moment the flag passes.'

David was born February 28, 1979, in Monterey Park, Calif. He was a three year veteran of the Inglewood Police Department, Inglewood, Calif., where his father served before him for 17 years. He was a 1998 graduate of El Segundo High School in El Segundo, Calif.

David was inducted into the U. S. Marine Corps, 1st Marine Division, in March of 1999 and served until August of 2003. He belonged to the 1st MEF in Operation Enduring Freedom and Operation Iraqi Freedom One. David was awarded many medals, including the Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal with combat “V” from Iraq.

He is survived by his parents, Ken and Cindy Frizelle of Ft. Mojave; two sisters, Kim Castruita of Canyon Country, Calif, and Laura Singer of Carson City, Nev.; two nephews, Zachary and Nicholas; and two nieces, Alyssa and Lauren. He has many relatives, dear cousins, and many, many friends.

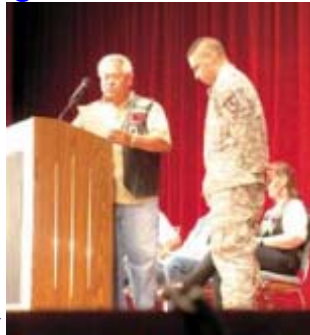

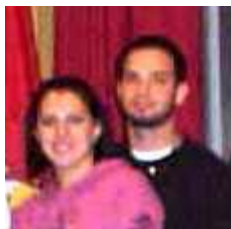
