Gary Leland Miller, age 66, passed away Thursday, January 1, 2009, in Bullhead City.

Gary was born in Minneapolis, Minn. He served as a medic in Vietnam and graduated from the University of Arizona as a Nurse Practitioner. He retired from the Bullhead City Fire Department.

He is survived by his wife, Paulette, four sisters, one brother, and many nieces and nephews.
